ECO4, a four-year obligation starting in April 2022, is estimated to have £1bn per annum in funding available and the LA Flex element will support 50% of the ECO obligation.

Working together to tackle fuel poverty

In response to the climate change crisis, the UK Government released their Net Zero Strategy, which sets out policies and proposals for decarbonising all sectors of the UK economy, to meet the net zero target by 2050.

Decarbonising residential buildings is key to achieving net zero and building a sustainable environment for future generations. The Department for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy (BEIS) advise that residential buildings contribute upto 23% of the greenhouse gas emissions.

This highlights the importance of improving the fabric efficiency and changing the way we heat our homes.

The latest definition of fuel poverty is now measured using the Low-Income Low Energy Efficiency Indicator (LILEE). 3.18 million households are said to be in fuel poverty in England. Following the impact of the Covid-19 pandemic, alongside the energy crisis, National Energy Action (NEA) estimates that the number of those households in fuel poverty are set to rise to over 6 million.
